The National Board recently approved a motion to create a tax exempt 501(c)(3)organization to be called The Vintage *Chevrolet Heritage* Foundation.

The purpose of this foundation will be the preservation of original Chevrolet and GMC information and literature. (The library that houses these types of information is now located at the ACCA *Library in Hershey, Pennsylvania.*)

The second motion, currently under consideration by the Board, is a change in the wording in the Judging Manual. The Judging Manual is being revised by the judging committee. This change would

standardize the language for judging CDPC (Chevrolet Driver Participation Class) cars. This wording should help to eliminate confusion when judging CDPC.

More information regarding the outcome of this motion will be discussed in a future G & D issue.
