It has come to our attention that money orders in Canadian Funds may be problematic for some members to get. In order to facilitate payments, we have created a US Registration Form with prices in US \$; then, our American Friends can simply write a US \$ cheque on their US accounts. A Club account in Canada can have up to \$60 US in collection fees whereas a personal account has no fees (go figure). Therefore, US \$ cheques have to be made payable to «Margaret Ross». This change was made on January 12th. Let your friends know. Either method is acceptable.

#### Directions:

Coming from Sarnia, Detroit, Buffalo or Niagara Falss, there are two major roads crossing Toronto. One is a toll road and the other is a not. Directions are given for both, you decide on the route.

• 1) There is the <u>toll road (407)</u> that can make a big difference in time & patience. This is an electronic toll road and you will be billed by mail at the end of

the month. There is a reciprocal agreement with the States for collection. If you choose this option, here is a **<u>hint</u>**: For those trailering an open

trailer, cover up the licence on the car as this may lead to a duplicate charge, do not cover the trailer plate.

• 2) The other road to use is the <u>401</u>. This will take you through the top of Toronto. Depending on the day, time, and traffic flow, this could be very slow

and take several hours just getting through Toronto. It may even test your patience. There are no tolls if you use this highway.

#### Parking, Trailers & Tow Vehicles:

- Trailers and motor homes must be parked at the Fleming College <u>(676 Dobbin Rd, Peterborough, ON)</u> parking lot before arriving at the motel. Directions take you to this location before you get to the motel. There is no room to maneuver trailers and motorhomes at the motel.
