

Tour will make this road trip a summer to remember



The Bellevue Gothic Mill is located on the bank of the Battle Creek River in

Bellevue, Michigan.

he Bellevue Gothic Mill is a Michigan Historic Site. The mill was built in 1854 by Horatio Hall for the local farmers to grind their grain into flour.

By 1888, the three ton waterwheel was replaced with steel roller mills and horsepower turbines to increase efficiency. The mill was closed for business in 1958. It remained abandoned for twenty years.

In 1977, William and Carol Jean Stockhausen bought the crumbling mill from the city of Bellevue for \$3,000.

Although the exterior was mostly completed by the timeline the city of Bellevue gave the Stockhausens, the major restoration inside took over 30 years to complete.

The mill is 45 feet long, 35 feet wide, with 19 foot walls of fieldstone that are three feet thick. The timbers are 14 by 14 inches.

Ownership of a vintage Chevrolet vehicle is not a prerequisite for membership. Lower Michigan Region dues are \$20 per year. To become a member, an applicant must be a National VCCA member in good standing. Yearly national dues are \$40.

May Dust-Off Tour Itinerary May 19-20

Day One: Meet at Wendy's, Durand, MI 9 a.m. 8581 East Lansing Rd. near exit 118 M71.

- Leave Wendy's on M71, cross over to I69 to Bennington Road.
- Turn left onto Bennington Rd through Vernon MI through farmland to Bancroft Rd.
- Turn left at Bancroft Road, drive one block, turn right onto Bennington Rd. Continue for 15 miles past State Road and M52 to Meridian Road.
- •Turn right (north) at Meridian Rd., continue 6 miles to light at M21, Ovid, MI.
- •Turn left (west), follow M21 or Bluewater Hwy 34 miles to Dexter St., Ionia MI.
- •Turn left (south) at North Dexter St. (Rite Aid Drugs at SE Corner). Dexter becomes M66 and continue south on M66 for 27.1 miles to Nashville.
- Cross over the Thornapple River in Nashville. Across the street from Marathon Station is the Good Times Pizza (501 N. Main Street). Meet there around 11 a.m. to stop, eat & stretch.
- ALTERNATE ROUTE from above directions: Take I69 to I96 West to Ionia Exit 67 and continue on M66 South toward Battle Creek. Nashville is north of Battle Creek on M66. Wait for us taking the scenic route.
- After leaving Good Times Pizza, go south on Main St. to Fuller St. (M79).
- Turn right at Fuller/M79, continue west 7.2 miles to Charlton Park Road.
- Turn right onto Charleton Park Rd. and right again into Charleton Park Village. Use north gate.
- We suggest giving donations to the parks as the hosts are volunteers.
- Upon leaving Charleton Park, turn left, then south on Charleton Park Rd. to Lawrence Rd. (M79).
- Turn left (east onto Lawrence Rd./ M79 to M66.
- Turn left (north) at M66 for 100 ft. and then right to M79 at blinking light intersection M66/79.
- Take M79 /Lawrence Rd. (east) to Charlotte.
- Drive on Lawrence Road north/M79 to Cochran Ave. in Charlotte, and turn south onto Cochran Ave. to East Shepard St/ Upland.
- Turn left (east) onto Shepard St./Upland to America's Best Value Inn, 828 East Shepard in Charlotte, which is near Meijer's Store. The phone number is 517-543-8288. Check in for the night. Evening Meal is at Eaton Place, 218 Cochran Ave., 517-543-6630. Turn west from east Shepard St. to Cochran St. Turn north or right on Cochran St. (M50) to Shell Station located on West Seminary St. . Turn left (west), go 100 ft, park on right side behind Eaton Place.

DAY TWO: Leave America's Best Value Inn around 9 a.m. Turn on west Shepard/ Upland St. to Battle Creek Road.

- Turn left onto Battle Creek Road to Bellevue, 11.3 miles away.
- In Bellevue, Battle Creek road turns into Capital Ave. Continue to Adams St.
- •Turn right (north) onto Adams St. at Citgo Station.
- •Drive two blocks to Bellevue Gothic Mill, which is located on the right.
- •A stop at Bellevue Gothic Mill is planned with tour and video presentation by owner Phill Stockhausen, restorer of the mill.
- We can use his dining facilities for lunch and meeting.
- •The director of the Bellevue Chamber of Commerce suggested we also visit the Mastadon display for upclose view of exhibits nd photo shots.
- •Leave the Bellevue Gothic Mill on Tanners Alley (west) to Main Street.
- •Turn left (south) at Main St. to 123 Main St. to see Beautiful Things Antique & Art and Grandma's Attic for long arm quilting and 100's of quilt patterns IF OPEN.

Corvette Engine Build Experience returns in 2018 reprinted from Hemmings Motor News, December 20, 2017, written by Kurt Ernst

In March 2015, Chevrolet's Performance Build Center in Bowling Green, Kentucky, reintroduced the Engine build Experience for buyers of seventh-generation Corvette's Z06 model . . . in January 2018 the Engine Build Experience returned for 2019 Corvette Z06 buyers, adding the option for buyers of the 2019 Corvette ZR1 in February. Priced at \$5,000, the Engine Build Experience gives those ordering the specified Corvette models the ability to asemble the car's supercharged V-8 --a 650 horsepower LT4 for the Z06 or a 750 horsepower LT5 for the ZR1, uder the supervision and guidance of an experienced Chevrolet engine assembly technician. Coordinated through the Natonal Corvette Museum, which acts as a concierge and coordinator for the program, the Engine Build Experience begins early in the morning, with introductions and a Continental breakfast at 5:45 a.m.

Following a safety briefing and photo session, the actual build process runs from 6:30 a.m. to 1:30p.m., interrupted by a 45 minute lunch beginning at 11 a.m. At the end of the assembly process, the engine is "cold tested" with the customr present before being sent to be mated with the buyer's Corvette chassis. The Performance Build Center also holds a completion ceremony for the Engine Build Experience participant, and takeaways include a poster of the buyer assembling the engine, images of the build shot by a professional photographer, a piston trophy with the customer's name and the date of the build, and a model-specific polo shirt and ball cap. The completed engine also receives a personalized plaque identifying the engine builder.

Ordering for 2019 Corvette Z06 models, including the Engine Build Experience Option, began November 30, while ordering for 2019 Corvette ZR1 was expected to begin on January 25, 2018...Museum Delivery remains available for Corvette Stingray and Grand Sport models as well.
