Besides cars, trucks, commercial vehicles, vintage campers, military vehicles, fire trucks, bicycles, wooden boats, all at least 25 years old, there may be 200 vehicle part swap meet vendors as well as craft vendors at the Red Barns Spectacular located at the Gilmore Car Museum, Hickory Corners, Michigan. And you won't want to miss the "High Noon Honk" when every vintage vehicle that has a horn will blast away!

For LMR members, breakfast will be hosted by Mike and Barb Sparks in Saranac from 9 a.m. - 10 a.m. Then it is time for the tour, a 40 mile trip to Gilmore. Maps and gate passes will be provided at the breakfast.

Modern vehicles will enter through the Spectator's Gate on the east end of the museum property. Those driving a modern vehicle will use the gate passes provided.

After parking, you may walk to the VCCA club's location at the north end of the show field oval, toward the west side of the museum property. If you need assistance traversing the property, ask at the entry gate.

Those driving a vintage Chevy will proceed to the west entry gate, show the gate pass pro-

vided, and follow directions to proceed to our reserved location. We are asking that you bring camp/folding chairs for whomever is in your party, and let us know if you can provide extras so that those who are walking from the spectator parking area do not have to haul things through the grounds. Lunch will be available at NOON at our club location. Soft drinks, water and light desserts will be provided too. You are free to roam the grounds, taking in the cars on the show field, voting for your favorites in the People's Choice Judging, checking out all the museum barns and looking for those wanted rare parts at the swap meet.

There are food vendors on site in case you have a craving for an ice cream cone or pretzel. And you can do what we do best: sit with our cars and enjoy our-friends and the atmosphere!

- 169 to 196 West towards Grand Rapids
- Take Exit 64 (Saranac, Lake Odessa Exit)
- Turn right (north) at end of ramp and then left (west) onto Grand River Ave.
- Drive 4 miles past both Herbruck Chicken/ Egg signs to Morrison Lake Road (Kountry Korners Party Store is at intersection)
- Turn right (north) onto Morrison Lake Rd for 2 miles. You will go through 2 curves and our property will be on left side (west) at corner of Morrison Lake Road and MacArthur Road

From the Detroit area to our home:

- 196 West towards Grand Rapids
- Take Exit 64 (Saranac, Lake Odessa Exit)
- Turn right (north) at end of ramp and then left (west) onto Grand River Ave.
- Drive 4 miles past both Herbruck Chicken/ Egg signs to Morrison Lake Road (Kountry Korners Party Store is at intersection)
- Turn right (north) onto Morrison Lake Rd for 2 miles. You will go through 2 curves and our property will be on left side (west) at corner of Morrison Lake Road and MacArthur Road

From the Kalamazoo/Hickory Corners Area

- M43 North to Village of Woodland
- Turn left (north) on M66 toward Ionia
- Take 196 West to Exit 64 (Saranac Lake Odessa)
- Turn right (north) at end of ramp and then left (west) onto Grand River Ave.
- Drive 4 miles past both Herbruck Chicken/ Egg signs to Morrison Lake Road (Kountry Korners Party Store is at intersection)
- Turn right (north) onto Morrison Lake Rd for 2 miles. You will go through 2 curves and our property will be on left side (west) at corner of Morrison Lake Road and MacArthur Road

From the Grand Rapids/Holland Area

- 196 East to Exit 59 (Clarksville/Saranac)
- Turn left (north) for half mile, turn right (east) onto Grand River Avenue for 2 miles
- Turn left (north)onto Morrison Lake Road for 2 miles (Kountry Korners Party Store is at intersection)
- You will go through 2 curves and our property will be on left side (west) at corner of Morrison Lake Road and MacArthur Road

From Mt. Pleasant area or alternate Flint area route

- US 127 South to exit 109, or M57 East, for 26 miles
- Turn left (south) on M66 for 14 miles to Ionia
- Turn right onto M21 (west) for 7 miles
- Turn left (south) at Saranac Corner, cross Grand River bridge. Don't blink: downtown is 1 block long!
- · Continue south through Saranac on Bridge St.
- Continue past Dollar General Store, up the hill, where Bridge St. becomes Morrison Lake Rd.
 Drive less than a mile south and our property is on right (west) side of road. See Gray Morton Bldg.


Directions to Gilmore from Sparks' home

- •Drive 3 mile south on Morrison Lake Road.
- •Turn right (west) at Portland Road for 1.5 miles.
- •At stop sign turn left (south) onto Nash Hwy. Drive 5 miles, including through the country town of Clarksville. At stop sign turn right (west) onto MI-50/Thompson Road and drive 2.5 miles.
- •Turn left (south) onto Hastings Road for 2 miles
- •Turn right (east) onto County Hwy 601 for 3 miles.
- As you enter the city of Hastings, County Hwy 601 becomes North Broadway Road. Drive a third of a mile.
- •Turn slight right onto North Broadway St/MI-43 and follow M-43 for 5 miles.
- •Turn right onto West State St/MI-43/MI-37/County Hwy-430 and continue to follow MI-43 for 19 miles. Really pretty drive along the lakes!
- •Make a left turn onto West Hickory Rd/County Hwy-400/ County Hwy 400P for a tenth of a mile. You will see the red barns and buildings that make up Gilmore Car Museum.
- •Gilmore Car Museum address is 6865 West Hickory Road,
