It was built in 1901 and used until 1966. A dam at the site was built in 1912 and the area had a lumber mill and gristmill in the mid 1800's. The gristmill gave way to a grain elevator, which

operated until 1969.

Another scenic drive on back roads took us to the small town of Maple



Rapids where we pulled into a former gas station for a photo shoot. The station is now a body shop/hobby shop. The shop was closed and we couldn't go in but it looked interesting.
