Turn right off Hammerberg on to Miller Road. Head east on Miller Road and follow on to one way 5<sup>th</sup> Street. Stay in left lane and turn left onto Church Street and right onto Second Street. Your may have to move a barricade to enter Second Street. If you do, please replace it. You will see the VCCA parking on the right side of Second Street just before Saginaw Street. The directions are somewhat changed from the past due to road construction.

It is recommended you arrive **AFTER 8:00 a.m. and BEFORE 9:00 a.m.** Saturday morning. If any of our spaces are vacant at 9:00 a.m., other collector vehicles will be allowed to park in the vacant spaces.
