Garage Tip

We live in the part of the country where bugs and mice seem to like to invade our workshops. Often we see a dead bug or two near the garage door, and of course, evidence that mice are on patrol looking for a place to nest or something to munch on.

One partial remedy is to place glue traps at various locations in the shop. I've found quite a few customers for my traps I place near doors, be it entry doors, or garage doors.

The brand "MaxCatch" has very sticky glue, and a peanut butter odor. The price on the web is about \$25 for 72 traps. The glue seems to last 4 or 5 months, although I'm sure the effectiveness wears out sooner. My barn cat will verify that the glue is very sticky as he has a "dickens" of a time plucking mice off the traps.
